

Cancel Your Current Plan at Any Time!

You do not need a reason to cancel a group plan or an Affordable Care Act marketplace plan at any time during the year. However, once you cancel, you may not reenter the ACA until the next renewal period.

Below, you will find **step-by-step instructions** on how to cancel your Affordable Care Act health insurance for you (and your family) at any time – if, like most people, you purchased it through HealthCare.gov. These instructions are provided by the federal government so please follow them strictly.

If you purchased your insurance through your state, you may go online in the state's portal to cancel. If you are in a group or employer plan, please check with them on how to cancel.

NOTE: Please **do NOT cancel your coverage** until you have confirmed your enrollment in our new FSI healthcare program and you have your medical cards (either physical or digital) in hand.

From Healthcare.gov:

If you're ending coverage for everyone on your new plan application, your termination can take effect as soon as the first day you cancel or you can set the Marketplace coverage to end on a day in the future – for example, several days AFTER your new plan takes effect.

You may end coverage for everyone on your plan for any reason, including sourcing health coverage from elsewhere.

Canceling coverage for everyone on your Marketplace plan (whether plan covers one person or multiple individuals in your family):

1. Login to your Marketplace account at healthcare.gov.
2. Click "start a new application or update an existing one."
3. Click on your name in the top right of the screen and select "My applications and coverage."
4. Select your application under "Your existing applications."
5. On the left, select "My plans and programs."
6. Click on the red button "End (terminate) All Coverage" at the bottom.
7. Select a date you want to end your coverage.
8. Check the attestation box.
9. Click the red "Terminate Coverage" box.

A red "Terminated" or "Canceled" status should appear above the plan you've canceled.
